
- Assess the environmental aspects relating to all our activities and the potential risks and opportunities; and implement appropriate measures to minimise environmental impacts
- Take steps to prevent pollution or other environmental incidents through risk management and emergency preparedness
- Make efficient use of energy, materials and natural resources
- Minimise waste through compliance with the waste hierarchy - in order of priority to prevent, reduce, re-use, recycle and recover, with landfill as the final option.
- Identify and meet our legal responsibilities and other environment-related compliance obligations
- Carry out work with due consideration for the general public, local residents and ecology
- To achieve Biodiversity Net Gain or No Net Loss on our projects
- Apply measures to prevent the spread of invasive plant species
- To reduce our carbon footprint and achieve organisational Net Zero Carbon by 2030, with an ambition to become Net Zero Carbon (CO₂e) by 2045 (including our supply chain)
- Use a life cycle approach to identify and address key environmental issues, and promote the adoption of innovative, sustainable and environmentally beneficial practices within our supply chain and with our clients
- Support our clients with the adoption of low-carbon and nature-based solutions
- Promote and ensure wider understanding of environmental issues amongst our employees through training and communications
- Achieve continual improvement in environmental performance

We shall implement our environmental management system in conjunction with other business systems and in conformance with ISO 14001 as a means of achieving this policy.

Management are responsible for ensuring that this policy is understood across all levels of the Company and that effective management systems are implemented. They will monitor performance, regularly evaluate effectiveness and set objectives and targets to provide a focus for continual environmental improvement.
